Thomas Dixon Centre – General Terms and Conditions

1. Application of Terms

1.1 By entering the Thomas Dixon Centre (TDC), you agree to comply with these General Terms and Conditions. These terms apply to all visitors, including but not limited to patrons, employees, contractors, and participants in activities held at the venue.

2. Safety and Security

2.1 TDC is committed to ensuring the safety and security of all visitors. All persons entering the venue must comply with any safety instructions given by staff or security personnel.

2.2 Bags and personal belongings may be subject to inspection upon entry.

2.3 Prohibited items, including but not limited to weapons, illegal substances, and hazardous materials, must not be brought into the venue.

2.4 The use of cameras, video recording devices, and other electronic equipment will be restricted at certain events, including performances in the Talbot Theatre or other activations and/or events that include children.

2.5 Visitors must act in a manner that does not endanger themselves or others. Disorderly conduct, including excessive noise, harassment, intoxication or disruption of performances or activities, will not be tolerated and may result in removal from the premises.

3. Child Safety

3.1 TDC is committed to providing a safe and supportive environment for children and young people.

3.2 All children under 16 years of age must be accompanied and supervised by a responsible adult at all times.

3.3 Any person engaging in inappropriate conduct, including harassment, bullying, or any form of abuse towards children, will be reported to authorities and may be banned from the venue.

3.4 All visitors to the must comply with TDC's Child Safety Policy at all times.

4. Privacy and Data Collection

4.1 By entering TDC, you acknowledge and agree to the collection and use of personal data in accordance with Queensland Ballet's (QB) Privacy Policy.

4.2 Personal information may be collected for security, ticketing, and operational purposes. This includes CCTV footage, booking information, and any personal details provided when engaging with TDC services.

4.3 QB may use personal data for marketing and promotional purposes, subject to applicable privacy laws. Visitors may opt out of receiving marketing communications at any time.

4.4 Personal data will not be shared with third parties unless required by law or with the explicit consent of the individual.

5. Conditions of Entry

5.1 Visitors must comply with all posted signage and staff directions while on-site.

5.2 Smoking, including e-cigarettes, is not permitted within TDC or within designated smoke-free areas.

5.3 Visitors must not bring or consume alcohol on the premises unless purchased from an authorised vendor within TDC.

5.4 TDC reserves the right to refuse entry or remove any person who fails to comply with these Terms and Conditions.

6. Limitation of Liability

6.1 Entry to TDC is at the visitor's own risk. TDC is not liable for any injury, loss, or damage sustained while on the premises, except to the extent required by law.

6.2 TDC will not be responsible for the loss or damage of personal property.

7. Amendments

7.1 TDC reserves the right to update or modify these Terms and Conditions at any time. Any changes will be published on the TDC website and take effect immediately.
